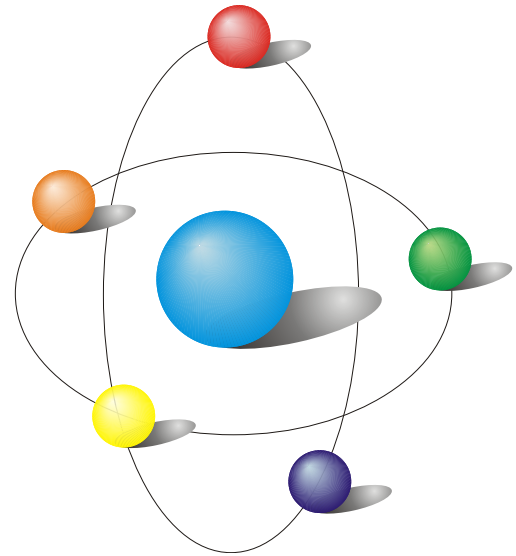


Leadership Skills for Project Managers

Before The Program

To participate in this program, candidates will be given four Leadership Skills assessment codes which they will give to four outside assessors. These assessors will be selected by the participant.

Successful selection of someone to do your Leadership Assessment depends on using a 360 degree approach. We recommend strongly that you choose:

- *one person to whom you have reported while in a project role,*
- *one person who has reported to you while in a project role,*
- *two people who have worked with you as a peer on a project team.*

Your assessments will be submitted anonymously; you won't know which person said what. This helps ensure honest and useful feedback about your leadership skills.

During The Program

When you come to the program you will do two personal assessments. One will focus on your knowledge of those issues affecting leadership and management. The other will be a personal assessment of your leadership skills.

Once you have this important baseline knowledge you will discover the secrets to understanding how people want you to lead them, and how you can be a better leader. The program will cover important information like:

- Ways in which your leadership style affects your team and your projects
- How to interpret the leadership preferences of those on your team
- How to adjust your own approach to make others more willing to be lead
- The difference between being a leader and being a manager
- How to lead and manage difficult project team members
